Maui Preservation Trades Training Workshop: Wooden Window Repair

Historic Hawaii Foundation (HHF) organized a two-day intensive, hands-on workshop providing theory and practical instruction in the repair and maintenance of historic wooden windows. The training presented pivotal skills in the repair and maintenance of historic wooden windows through the introduction of foundational preservation principles and practices, visits to local historic sites to practice documentation and assessment skills, demonstrations by expert instructors and hands-on practice by trainees.

The workshop was held on April 16-17, 2026 at the University of Hawaii Maui College, Kahului, Maui and local historic sites in Wailuku, Maui. The program brought together a diverse alliance of project partners and participants. There were 19 trainees, five master carpenter instructors, a Secretary of the Interior-qualified historic architect, and three HHF staff members for a total of 27 participants from Maui, Molokai, and Oahu.
